### SECURITY

#### **Guard Amount & Locations**

- (75) Guards
  - Industry standards recommend (1) Guard per (100) attendees for ticketed events. So we're going to aim for (1) Guard per (150) attendees plus an additional (10) Guards. 8,000-12,000 guests will make their way towards Rachel, NV. Our planned Capacity will be 10,000.
  - o 30 Guards at the entrance of Rachel for vehicle checks.
    - There will be a single entry point where vehicles cycle through the town of Rachel. In an assembly-line format, the Guards will perform vehicle checks on a rotational schedule of 3-5 minutes.
  - o 25 Guards stationed inside of Main Festival-Grounds
    - (5) Stationed Directly Inside the Gates
    - (6) Stationed Near Vendors
    - (12) Guards for Main Stage
    - (5) Guards for Side-Stage
  - o 10 Guards patrolling grounds inside & around perimeter
    - Constant Potrols of Perimeter for Breaks & Tears
  - o 10 Outside Perimeter
    - (2) Guards in VIP area
    - (8) Guards patrolling grounds

#### **Vehicle Checks**

#### All Entering Vehicles Will Be Checked

- Special Entry Passes for Staff Re-Entry will be in place
  - Staff and Resource vehicles will be allowed 'fast-entrance'
- o Weapons & Contraband will be seized
  - Security will search for weapons as a primary target
- o Dealing amounts of Drugs to be confiscated & reported
  - Large amounts of pre-packaged or lump concentrations of illicit substances will be reported to local law enforcement

#### Assembly-Line Vehicle Checks

- Parking staff at the entrance will guide (30) vehicles down Groom Avenue towards a stopping point.
- All (30) vehicles will then come to a complete stop where (30) Guards will be lined up respectively.

- Over the course of (3) minutes, the Guards will individually search their vehicle and approve it.
- Parking staff will then usher the (30) cars down to their designated parking zones.
  - Afterwards, another (30) cars will fill up their places and repeat the process.

#### **Festival Checks**

- Backpacks
  - No Multi-Pocket Backpacks, only these are allowed:
    - Hydration Pack with (1) pocket.
    - Drawstring Backpack
- Fannypacks
  - o Fanny packs allowed
- Purses
  - No oversized purses

with the nearest hospital being about 80 minutes away and the nearest trauma center over two hours away.

#### First-Aid Tent

- o First-Aid Tent will be located within the festival grounds
- Will be able to accommodate up to (8) EMTs.

#### **PARKING & LOGISTICS**

#### **Parking Personnel**

- Traffic-Focused Staff
  - Minimum (25) Parking Staff inside inside Rachel
    - (11) Stationed Along Traffic Paths
    - (10) Stationed in Parking Lots
      - (4) in each of the larger lots
      - (2) in the staff lot
  - o (4) Vehicle Markers
    - (4) Parking Staff will be located at the entrance to mark incoming vehicles with the correct lettering:
      - (G) General Car Parking
      - (S) Staff Car Parking
      - (M) Media Car Parking
      - (V) VIP Car Parking
      - (R) RV Parking

### Logistics

#### In-Town Traffic

- Both Northbound & Southbound traffic will enter Rachel on the Northside entrance. All vehicles will initially enter the front portion of Penoyer Farm Road. (A road-block will be placed after the turn for Groom Avenue)
- General, Staff, & VIP parking will be guided down Groom Avenue for the assembly-line vehicle check.
  - Staff will be led down Templute Drive and Grover Avenue to their parking lot
  - General Parking & VIP will be led down Canyon Road to their respective lots.
    - VIP will be ushered down Central Way to their lot.

#### **WASTE MANAGEMENT**

#### **Toilets**

- o (100) Total Toilets Needed.
  - Industry standards recommend (1) toilet for every (100) attendees
- o (5) Handicap-Accessible Toilets
  - 5% of toilets are recommended to accommodate the handicapped
  - (1) Placed at each Toilet-Line/Grouping
- o (95) Regular Toilets shall be placed around the festival & campgrounds
  - (50) Toilets Inside the Festival Grounds
  - (20) Toilets Along Vendor-Alley
  - (25) Spread out across the 3 Parking Lots

#### **Trash & Material Waste**

- (120) Waste Barrels Scattered Throughout Festival/Campgrounds
  - (60) Barrels Located inside Festival Grounds
- o All Barrels Replaced once to twice-a-day
  - Unless 50% remains unfilled
- o (1,000+) Garbage Bags
  - Extra bags to be given to attendees to encourage pick-up
- o (2) 40' Dumsters

#### **Material & Waste Removal**

- Toilet Waste removal to take place daily
  - Early-Mornings on Saturday & Sunday
- Material Waste removal to take place after event
  - Garbage bags that are removed daily will be transported in dumpsters at the end of the festival
